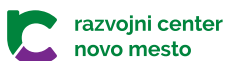

## More about Novo mesto General Hospital

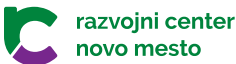

The Mobility Plan promotes the active use of sustainable modes of access to the hospital, reducing arrivals by private car and the associated carbon footprint of transport.



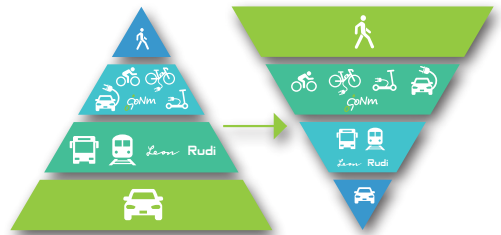
## Increasing awareness of sustainable mobility
